The Dredging Corporation of India Limited invites sealed bids in Two cover System (Techno-Commercial Bid (Envelope A) and Price Bid (Envelope B)) from eligible bidders for Re-Importing of pipes and accessories as mentioned in Annexure-A from Mongla Port, Bangladesh to Lova Garden, Visakhapatnam by Road which Includes loading at Mongla, Bangladesh, transportation, transhipment including parking charges, customs clearance at Bangladesh and Indian customs and Unloading at designated place at Lova Garden, Visakhapatnam.

A brief about Materials: These pipes and materials are ship spares which were initially imported to India and were used for pipe line dredging works. Recently, these items were exported to Bangladesh for dredging works on **returnable** basis and now the dredging work is going to complete. We propose to re-Import these items to India.

- **1.5** The EMD will be forfeited in favour of Dredging Corporation of India Ltd., if the tenderer backs out after opening of tenders or After corporation communicates its acceptance of offer quotation or if the tenderer modifies the tender after opening.

THE TENDER SHALL BE GOVERNED BY THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

 Tenders should be submitted in sealed cover duly super scribed with the Tender name (Tender for Import of Pipes & Accessories from Mongla, Bangladesh to Lova Garden, Visakhapatnam by road) Number (DCI/MAT/IMPORT TO VISAKHAPATNAM/2019-20/01 DT:22.05.19) and due date addressed to the Materials Division, Dredging Corporation of India Ltd., Visakhapatnam - 530001,so as to reach not later than 1500Hrs on 03.06.2019. Late tenders will not be Considered. Local tenderers if so desired may deposit their Tender in the tender box provided for this purpose before due time and date. DCI is not responsible for postal delay. Tenders in any other form or in complete tenders are likely to be rejected.

Note :- Before submitting the tender, all are requested to visit the site to know the exact dimensions of material and the scope of work and accordingly submit the offer.

- 2. Offers submitted vide FAX/EMAIL shall not be considered.
- 3. The tender be opened at1530Hrs on due date 03.06.2019 in the presence of such tender who are present at the time of opening.
- 4. All tender must be absolutely clear and qualified, failing which the same will not be considered.
- 5. All columns should be properly filled in the price bid format provided without leaving any column as blank and tender documents should be signed and attested by authorized person with company seal. Any correction in the rates etc. should be duly attested by the offered. Alterations not authenticated, with attestation may result in rejection of tender. Prices should be quoted in Indian Rupees only.
- 6. Any revision of rates after opening of tender will not be accepted.
- 7. The offer should be kept open for acceptance for three months from the date of Opening of Tender.
- 8. GST as applicable shall be payable extra as applicable. The Percentage of GST prevailing should be indicated separately failing which it will be considered as the rates are inclusive of all taxes and duties.
- 9. Delivery of the materials required maximum of 30 Days from the date of work order, however the number of days may be reduce to minimum as possible.

- 10. 100% payment will be made within 30 days from the date of submission of invoice and other related documents subjected to receipt of materials in full and in good condition including copy of acknowledgement by DCI Official at Lova Garden, Visakhapatnam.
- 11. Please furnish bank account details for the purpose of releasing payment by Electronic transfer.

Note: - Vendors who are attending for opening of tender should bring authorization letter, failing which they may not be allowed for opening of tender.

- 12. Insurance is under scope of DCI. However utmost care should be taken by the transporters while transporting of material. Any damages occurred during the transportation and handling to be borne by the transporter.
- 13. Dredging Corporation of India Limited reserves the rights to select other transporters or cancellation of work order at any stage. No claim what so ever may be entertained on this account.
- 14. The disputes, if any arising between the vendor and DCI shall be resolved in the jurisdiction of court at Vishakhapatnam.
- 15. **Security Deposit**: 5% on work order value to be submitted within 5 days from the date of receipt of work order in form of BG or NEFT/RTGS to DCIL, Visakhapatnam to the current account.
- 16. After award of work order, if the supplier fails to complete work in full within the prescribed delivery period, then the corporation reserves the right for followings:
 - a. To recover from the supplier, liquidated damages and not by way of penalty, a sum not less than 1% of the value of work order if the supplier failed to deliver the material as aforesaid, for each day subject to maximum of 10% of basic work order value during which the completion of such order may be in arrears.
 - b. To cancel the order or portion thereof , and if so decided, to process a fresh order on alternative sources at the risk and cost of the supplier. The manner and method of such purchase shall be in entire is creation of the Corporation.

17. Amendment of Bidding Documents:

a. At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, the DCI may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by prospective bidder, modify the Bidding Documents by amendment.

- b. The amendment will be notified in writing or by mail to all prospective Bidders which have received the Bidding Documents and will be binding on them.
- c. In order to afford prospective Bidders reasonable time in which to take the amendment into account in preparing their bids, the DCI may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of bids.
- 18. The bidders shall give an undertaking that they have not made any payment or illegal gratification to any person/authority connected with the bid process so as to influence the bid process and have not committed any offence under the prevention of corruption act in connection with the bid.
- 19. The bidders shall disclose any payments made or proposed to made to any intermediaries (agents etc.) in connection with the bid.
- 20. The Corporation reserves all rights to accept or reject any tender in part or in full without assigning any reason thereof.
- 21. All matters of disputes shall be governed by the Indian Arbitration Act 1996 Any disputes arising out of this shall be subjected to Visakhapatnam Jurisdiction only.
- 22. All the statutory obligations not specified above but which are supposed to be fulfilled by the bidder including Environmental Pollution Control norms, as required to be followed, are included in the contract for its fulfilment and therefore, the agent shall keep DCI indemnified for all the consequences in case of default reported by any statutory agency.
- 23. The successful bidder shall comply with all applicable State & Central laws, statutory rules, regulations, etc.
- 24. The DCI, Visakhapatnam reserves the right to accept or reject any offer or withdraw tender without assigning any reason
- 25. **Arbitration:** In the event of any dispute and/or difference arising between the Purchaser /Buyer and/or their Agent/Seller as to the construction, interpretation and or execution of the contract and/or execution of the contract and/or the respective rights and liabilities of the parties, such disputes and/or differences shall be referred to the Sole Arbitration of the Chief Executive of the Principal for a Company registered under the Companies Act. In case of a PSUs; the Head of the Department in case of a Govt. Department. Ordnance Factory Board Units/Defence Units, who may act himself or nominate in his stead any officer subordinate to him or of MSTC being not below the rank of General Manager/Director in the Govt. Dept. who shall act as the Sole Arbitrator. The provisions of the Indian Arbitration Act. 1995, and the Rules there

under shall apply to such Arbitration. The award passed by such Sole Arbitrator shall be final and shall conclusively bind all the parties.

- 26. **Jurisdiction:** The contract shall be governed by all relevant Indian Acts applicable only within the jurisdiction of Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh.
- 27. **Black-Listing:** DCI reserve the right to black-list, debar any bidder/agent due to any act of omission or commission or fraudulent acts indulged or caused to be indulged by such bidder/agent in the course of bidding process and/or in the execution or performance of any of the contracts which may be awarded to the bidder/agent , provided however, that the DCI shall be obliged to allow an opportunity of being heard to such bidder/agent before any order of blacklisting/ debarment could be passed. Any such order of black listing/debarment that may be passed by the company shall be without prejudice to other right of actions available to the company against the bidder/agent under tender terms and conditions.
- 28. **Forfeiture of Security Deposit:** In case the whole or any part of the work left incomplete after the authorized period stated in the delivery order, DCI reserves the right to forfeit the Security amount deposited by the agent.
- 29. **Over Dimension**: Over dimension charges will be paid by DCIL upon the submission of documentary proof.
